Tournament Sponsorship Options

Sirocco allows On-Course Food & Beverage Sponsors.

All sponsors must be approved by Sirocco Golf Club no later than fourteen days prior to the tournament date by submitting a sponsorship agreement form to your Event Manager; some fees may apply.

Liquor Sponsorship

All sponsored liquor must be handled and served by Sirocco Golf Club Staff; corkage fees and/or liquor service fees may be applied.

In the event that a liquor sponsor is legally certified to serve liquor on premises, in accordance with AGLC regulations, a corkage fee will be applied to each item served.

Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverage Sponsorship

On-Course food giveaways are permitted within reason and pending approval from Sirocco Golf Club. Any items served must adhere to current food safety regulations and be served by a licensed food provider where applicable.

Meal Sponsorship

Charitable events may wish to have a portion of the tournament fee donated by a sponsor. Options for this include:

Clubhouse Overview



Rooms are designated based on the final number of guests at your tournament.

A Full Shotgun Tournament is granted our Full Upper Clubhouse for the duration of the event.

Access to the room is provided on the day of the tournament. Various event layout options are available to accommodate registration areas, silent and live auctions, prize tables and more.

The Montage Room

Our Montage Room is south facing and features a large private patio, floor to ceiling windows that showcase the beauty of the Pine Creek Valley and the golf course. **This room is suitable for groups of up to 48 guests.**

El Sirocco & Ibby's Lounge

By opening the sliding door between these two rooms we create a fabulous group booking area that is **suitable for groups between 48 and 120 guests**. Our lounge features a gorgeous granite bar and corner fireplace, as well as breathtaking views of the Calgary Skyline from the private deck.

Full Upper Clubhouse

Our Full Upper Clubhouse features floor to ceiling windows throughout, both city and mountain views from two private patios, granite bar, wine wall, corner fireplaces, beautiful understated artwork and a large cocktail area. **The Full Upper Clubhouse will be made available for shotgun tournaments larger than 120 guests.** Our facility can accommodate up to 200 guests.



Tournament Policies

Dress Code

- The dress code will be enforced at all times on the golf course and practice facility. This includes: soft soled shoes or soft spikes only, NO FLIP FLOPS or DENIM. Men are required to wear a collared shirt and women's shirts without sleeves must have a collar, whereas women's shirts with sleeves do not require a collar.
- It is encouraged that the Tournament Organizer informs all guests and sponsors about our dress code prior to arrival to avoid disappointment, as those not dressed appropriately will be asked to change.

Weather

- Tournaments will be required to play unless the course is deemed unplayable by the Golf Course Superintendent.
- Tournaments will be interrupted in the event of lightning. Play will proceed after conditions are once again deemed safe.

Food & Beverage

- Sirocco Golf Club will be the sole provider of all food and beverage items. Our facility is licensed and therefore will not allow any alcohol that is not purchased from the clubhouse, beverage carts or halfway house.
- In certain circumstances exceptions may be made for sponsored alcoholic items, provided that:
- Approval has been obtained from Sirocco Golf Club at least 14 days prior through a Sponsorship Agreement Form;
- All liquor handling and service adheres to Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commission (AGLC) regulations.
- Sirocco Golf Club retains the right to charge a corkage fee for any approved outside liquor served on premise.
- All alcohol will be served in accordance to AGLC requirements. Extended liquor license hours may be requested but are subject to approval from the AGLC.
- In the interest of safety and speed of play the club may limit the amount of liquor served on course.
- Any changes to meal service time on the day of the event must be confirmed with the Events Manager by no later than 2.5 hours prior to the originally scheduled meal time.



Tournament Food & Beverage Sponsorships

- Food & Beverage Sponsorship may be permitted with the approval of your Events Manager no later than 14 days prior to the tournament.
- Special permission may be requested for On-Course Food & Beverage Sponsorships (ie. BBQ's, pizza, pop & snack handouts, etc). A fee may apply to offset the loss of potential revenue and will be discussed and reviewed when the Sponsorship Agreement Form is submitted.

Booking & Payment

- A \$500 deposit is due for groups of 40-72 players, and a \$1,500 deposit is due for groups with 72+ players when the booking contract is submitted. This amount will be applied towards your final invoice.
- Deposit can be made by cash, debit, credit or cheque payable to Sirocco Golf Club.
- A \$10,000 pre-payment deposit is due 14 days prior to the tournament for groups of 100 or more.
- All deposit payments are non-refundable and non-transferable once received by Sirocco.
- A credit card must be provided upon booking for any incidentals (host bar, ticket bar, carts, concessions, damages to course/carts, etc). The credit card number given must be valid through the event date.
- The final number of tournament participants must be submitted to your Event Manager no later than 14 days prior to the tournament date. The tournament will be charged for this minimum number of players from this point forward. Additional participants may be added after this two-week mark at the regular per player package price.
- The minimum number of golfers confirmed 14 days prior to the tournament date must be no less than 20% of what is originally indicated on the booking agreement.
- If the number of participants confirmed 14 days prior to the tournament date falls below 120 players, the tournament no longer qualifies for a full shotgun start, and we reserve the right to modify the shotgun start.

General

- Minimum number of golfers to hold a tournament is 40; maximum is 144. If you have 40 golfers or less please contact us about our group bookings.
- Player foursomes list must be submitted using Sirocco's Draw Template by the Tournament Organizer at least 3 days prior to the event.
- Tournament Organizers shall be held responsible for ensuring participants follow tournament policies.
- Any damages to the course, carts, rental clubs and/or clubhouse will be billed to the Tournament.
- Sirocco will not assume any responsibility for tournament property, sponsored property or participant belongings and equipment brought onto the premises.
- Tournament and sponsor set-up times and specifications must be pre-approved by your Event Manager; we reserve the right to decline any set-up that we deem unsuitable, hazardous or damaging to Sirocco's property.
- We reserve the right to apply a fee to any event set-up that falls outside the scope of normal tournament set-up.



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Tournament Checklist

One Week Prior to Tournament

- ☐ Submit the On-Course Tournament Design Form listing all proxies, competitions, and on-course activities (spreadsheet will be provided by your Events Manager)

Three Days Prior to Tournament
