Hockey Details:

- (7), 60-minute ice sessions will focus primarily on skill development and will be non-contact.
- Parents are encouraged to spectate during our Friday ice time which will be a game day. During this time athletes will get a chance to showcase the skills they have learned throughout the week in a competitive setting.
- · All ice times will be at Cardel Rec South.
- Each ice sessions will have (3) instructors/coaches (max 1:8 skater to coach ratio) and will be led by Rock Ruschkowski.

Golf Details:

- There will be a total of (5), 60-minute golf practice sessions that will occur each morning. Each session will dedicate 30-minutes to full swing practice on the driving range and 30-minutes of short game area practice.
- During the on range portion golfers will work on and develop the basic fundamentals of the game including grip, posture, alignment & contact.
- The short game portion will focus on developing golfers putting and chipping skills while learning how to read greens.
- 3 days of the week golfers will get a chance to demonstrate what they have learned and play 9 holes on course at the Sirocco Golf Club.
- All practice sessions will have (3) instructors (Max 1:8 student to instructor ratio) and will be led by Rock Ruschkowski.

Outdoor Multi-sport Details:

- Each day has 60-minutes dedicated to an outdoor multi-sport activities.
 This will consist of a variety of games that include soccer, flag football, capture the flag, basketball and ultimate frisbee.
- Outdoor multisport sessions will be conducted at the Bishop O'Bryne Highschool field just outside of Cardel Rec South facility.

Bussing

 Athletes will bus to and from Cardel Rec South facility each day. Bus ride is approximately 15 minutes in length each way.

Pre-Requisites

- Hockey: must have played at least one year of organized hockey.
- Golf: No prior experience needed.
- All Participants are required to bring the following items with them each day:
 - Full hockey equipment (Helmet w/ full face shield, shoulder/elbow/shin pads, hockey pants/socks, neck guard, pelvic protector, skates, gloves, stick.)
 - Golf clubs, tees and golf balls.
 - Water bottle.
 - Sufficient snacks and lunch for the day.
 - Attire suitable for both golf and outdoor multisport activities.

Rock Ruschkowski (Head Instructor & PGA of Canada Professional)

A born and raised Calgarian Rock grew up playing competitive hockey with the Calgary Northstars program before moving to Saskatchewan to pursue hockey at the junior "A" level where he split 3 seasons between the Humboldt Broncos and Melfort Mustangs of the SJHL. It was during the off seasons while playing with these clubs that Rock fell in love with the game of golf while working at the Sirocco Golf Club in their proshop.

His dedication and love for both sports allowed him to earn a scholarship to the Southern Alberta Institute of Technology (SAIT) as a dual sport athlete in both hockey and golf. He spent 4 years competing for both the SAIT Trojans Golf and Hockey teams and graduated from the Civil Engineering Technology program in 2022.

After graduation Rock earned his PGA of Canada professional status and has worked as an assistant golf professional at the Sirocco Golf Club for the past 3 seasons. In 2024, he became a Class "A" professional and was named to the PGA of Alberta's top 100 golf professionals list.

Post hockey playing career, Rock has continued his passion in the game of hockey through coaching. His experience includes coaching the Hockey Canada Skills Academy (2022), U15 AAA Okotoks Oilers (2022-2023) and he is currently an assistant coach with the SAIT Trojans Men's Hockey Team.
