Information

Sirocco Golf Club provides junior golfers (ages 5-18) the chance to enjoy and learn the game of golf through an affordable and accessible junior program.

The Sirocco Golf Club offers both chartered and public junior memberships. Chartered juniors are the children or grandchildren of our charter members. Junior memberships are available to the general public. Juniors are encouraged to utilize the practice facility and golf course as much as possible.

Included in the membership is the following:

- Unlimited golf with 7 day advance booking. Anytime Monday through Thursday outside of league play and any time after 3 pm on Fridays, Weekends and holidays.
- Chartered juniors can play anytime outside of league play but must be accompanied by their member parent in the restricted times.
- Priority and discounted access to Operation 36 Classes (additional fee)
- Unlimited range and practice facility access
- Included Golf Canada Membership
- Sunday Junior Nights
- Discounted Private Lesson Rates
- Priority access to Junior Group Lessons (additional fee)
- Participation in Sirocco Junior Club Championships
- Participation in Foothills Junior Interclub Tour Events
- Optional Charge Accounts available

Code of Conduct

Our Junior members are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and respectful manner at all times while at the facility. Our juniors are also expected to behave this way while representing the club at other golf courses whether playing for team Sirocco at interclub events, other tournaments or just a casual round of golf. Sirocco Golf Club will not tolerate inappropriate behavior including:

- Interfering with the learning environment of other players Harassment of any kind including abuse, fighting, threats and other inappropriate behavior
- There will be ZERO tolerance towards any forms of bullying
- Any behavioral issues will be brought to the attention of the parent immediately. If behavioral issues persist, Sirocco reserves the right to remove the junior from membership with written notice. A dues refund will not be issued.
- Power Carts are not to be driven by any junior members
- Juniors must adhere to basic golf course etiquette including; Pace of Play juniors are required to understand time pars and follow them.
- Course care It is critical that all members replace divots, rake bunkers and repair ball marks.
- If juniors are joined with another group or are playing on their own they are to act respectfully and with accordance to the Sirocco Code of Conduct.
- Juniors 12 and over can play unaccompanied on the golf course and practice facility. Juniors between the ages of 10 and 12, must pass a knowledge and etiquette test. Juniors under 10 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Code of Conduct

- Please show up 15 minutes prior to your tee time and check in with the pro shop
- Dress Code Sirocco Junior Members are to adhere to the dress enforced at the club:
- Proper golf shoes (soft spikes) or runners are required.
- Jeans are not permitted on the course, driving range or putting greens.
- Shirts for men must have a collar. Women's tops may have a collar with no sleeves or no collar with sleeves. All shorts must have an inseam of no less than six inches with a finished hem.

Pace of Play

Junior members are to adhere to the pace of play policies instituted at the club

- * 5th Tee 1 Hour
- * Finish 9 Holes 2 Hours and 5 Minutes
- * 14th Tee 3 Hours and 5 Minutes
- * Finish 18 Holes 4 Hours and 15 Minutes

Operation 36

The Operation 36 development model is a revolutionary program for all golfers that encourages students to shoot 36 in 9 holes from progressive yardages. Students start with 25 yard holes and work their way back to the full tee-boxes.

Juniors deserve a better way to learn to play golf!

Most junior programs are incomplete. That is why the Sirocco Junior Academy uses the Operation 36[®] Development Model which centers around playing golf. The goal is to help your junior shoot par (36) or better for 9 holes.

STEP ONE: Learn Skills in Fun Classes

We make learning the game feel like a game! Your junior will make friends and learn skills in fun engaging classes.

STEP TWO: Play Their First 9 Holes

Coaches will provide your junior with a 9 hole playing experience with the Op 36 Model.

STEP THREE: Train & Track Progress

The Op 36 Mobile App is your families guide to practicing and playing golf outside of classes.

GAMIFIED (FUN) CURRICULUM



At Sirocco Golf Club we believe that every golf program should be centered around playing golf and making it fun to track progress over time. This is why our facility is excited to be a licensed Operation 36[®] facility. We leverage the Op 36 Development Model (see below) and technology to make it fun for our golfers to improve their skills.

Mastering the Operation 36 Model:

Golfers Play 9 Holes From Division 1 (25 Yards)

Instead of starting at the full tee box, all golfers begin in Division 1 and will play 9 holes starting 25 yards from each green.


Shoot par (36) or better to pass Division

When they shoot par (36) or better, the golfer progresses to Division 2, where they start 50 yards from each green.

Complete the Division 10 challenge

This challenge continues until the golfer can shoot par (36) from all 10 divisions!





Operation 36

At Sirocco, our Operation 36 program consists of 12 sessions over the course of 8 weeks. This is comprised of 8 - 50 minute practices (max 8:1 student to instructor ratio) and 4 - 9 hole game days. Practices will be weekly Thursday evenings and game days will be bi-weekly on Sunday afternoons.

As golfers progress through the program and complete each division they will tee off from different yardages on each of the 4 game days.

There will be two 8-week Operation 36 program series this season. The schedule for each of the series can be seen below:

Junior Night

On 9 different Sunday evenings throughout the season junior night will occur. Junior night will run a little differently than in previous seasons in 2024, as there will not be a formal clinic like in previous years prior to golf.

Junior night will consist of 10 tee times blocked off (total of 40 players) after 5:00 pm where only juniors can play 5-9 holes.

Junior night is FREE and is a great way for juniors to interact with other members of the club while having fun and hopefully learning something new in the game of golf.

Juniors under the age of 11 require one parent volunteer to assist with their tee times. Parents are asked to help monitor safety & etiquette (repairing divots, ball marks, raking bunkers, directing & keeping score). Information will be provided to the parent volunteer to help them understand and regulate expectations.

Juniors will be required to book these tee times on their own for junior night either through the Chronogolf app or by calling into the Proshop (403-201-5505).

Junior Group Clinics

Junior Group Lessons Ages 7-14

Our junior group clinics are geared towards beginner golfers that are looking for an introduction to the game in a group setting.

Our educated PGA of Canada instructors have designed a series of lessons that will focus on participation and teach the fundamentals of golf in a fun and active environment. Proven concepts from the CN Future Links Learn to Play Program, Operation 36 and the US Kids Golf Program are integrated into these lesson designs creating our very own Sirocco recipe for junior golf development.

Our junior group clinic program is broken up into 3 separate series of 3 45-minute lessons taking place on consecutive Sunday's throughout the season. Each series is separate and non sequential so you do not need to take part in a previous series to register for the next one.

May Series (1:00-1:45) May 11, 18, 25 June Series (1:00-1:45) June 1, 8, 15 July Series (1:00-1:45) July 13, 20, 27

- Winning team after Interclub Championship will receive new Foothills Interclub Trophy


